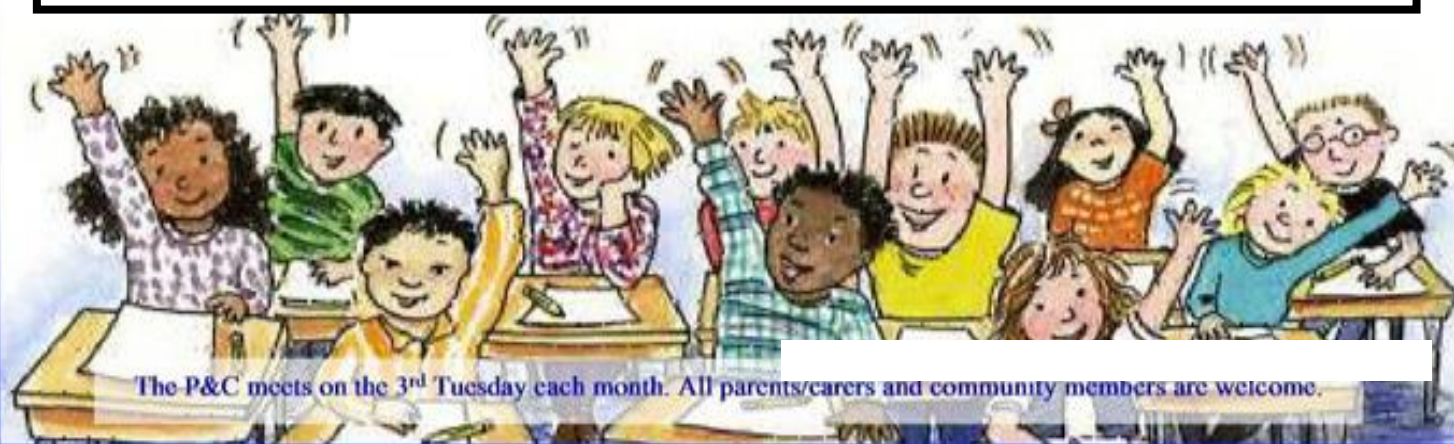

as there is no school supervision available after 3pm.

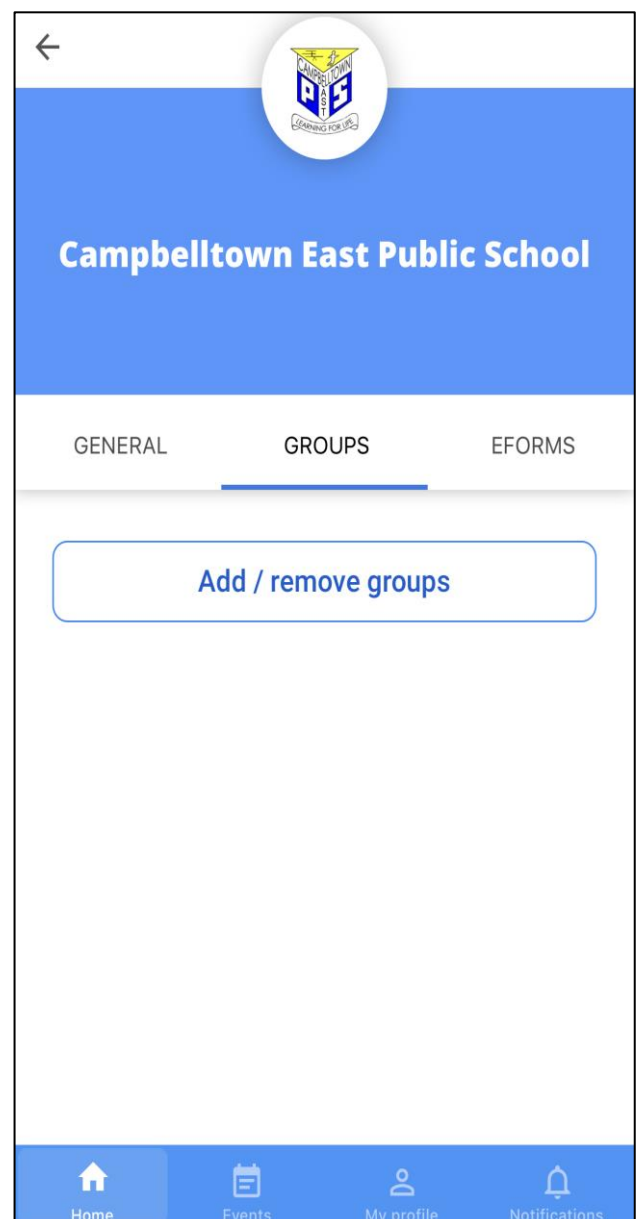
## Notes Home

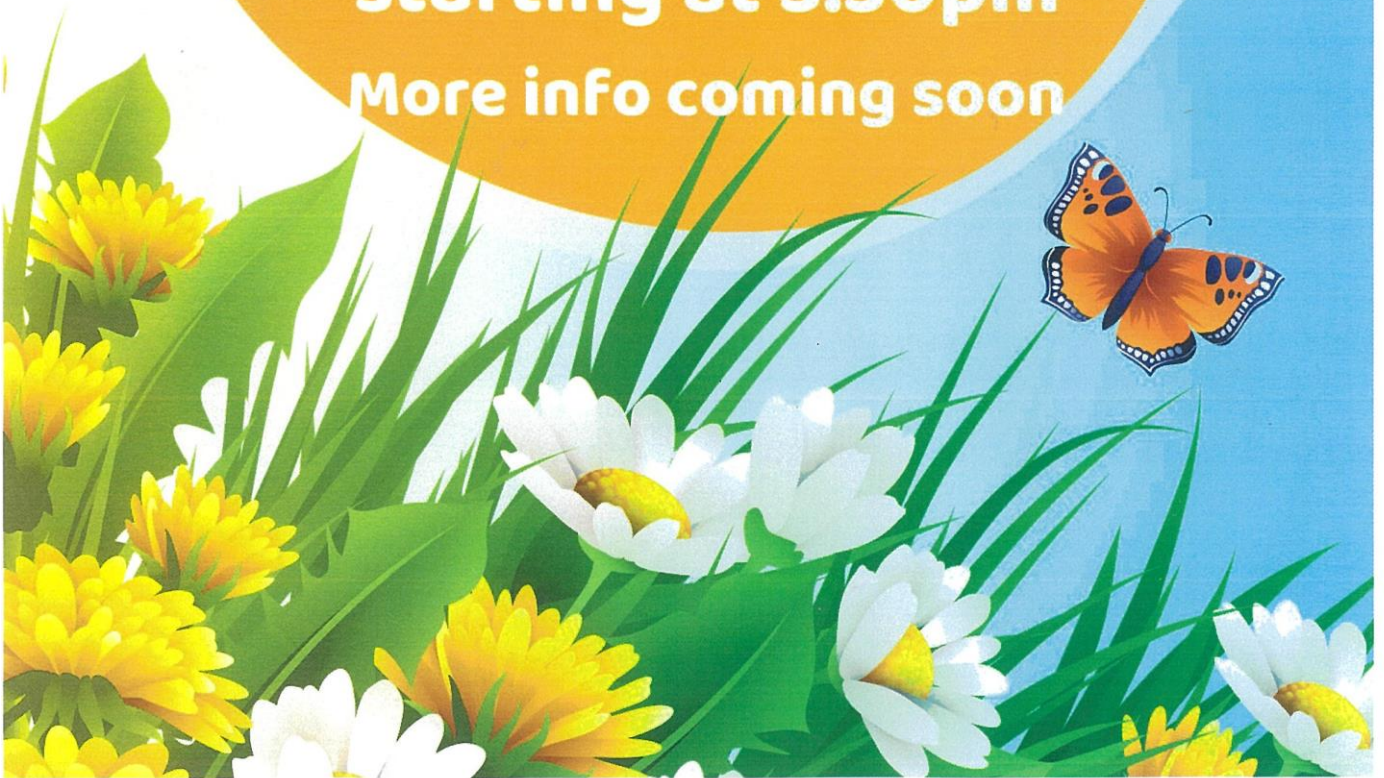

How to Apply:

1. Complete all pages of the enrolment form
2. Complete direct debit form
3. Attach child's immunisation record
4. Hand all documents to coordinator of service
5. If your child is medicated with asthma or is anaphylaxis you will need to bring in a action plan from your GP and their medication that will stay on site permanently

Upon enrolment you will be asked to confirm enrolment in tasks through the mygov centerlink app
